

Motions Passed at Munster Convention Auburn Lodge Hotel Feb. 1st 2013

Administration/General

1. That all Championship competition entry forms online or otherwise should have columns for (a) Athlete's Name, (b) Date of Birth, (c) Current Registration Number, (d) Competition Category for Masters, Juniors, Seniors etc.
2. That a complete list of (a) Names, (b) Dates of Birth, (c) Current Registration Number of all athletes entered for Championship Competition should be sent by the relevant Competition Secretary to the Munster Registrar for verification prior to all Competitions.
3. That when a Juvenile Athlete is being contacted directly by an Official of A.A.I. that his/her Club Secretary/Chairperson must be notified immediately and simultaneously by E-mail or by post and by that Official in the interest of Child Welfare. (Official means County, Provincial, National Officials/Officers, Non Home Club Coaches and R.D.O's.
4. That the date for the Munster Star Awards Banquet be flexible to avoid clashes with Championship Fixtures, but should be held not later than mid-February.

Track/Field

1. That Munster Council include an individual dimension to the U9, 10, 11 Juvenile Team Competition as follows,
 - (a) All athletes compete in the normal way.
 - (b) The 2 x Team Results are made up/calculated in the normal way, by combining their results for 1st, 2nd, 3rd team places who qualify for All-Ireland's and be presented with team medals.
 - (c) The top 3 athletes in each event be presented with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd individual medals, but only athletes on teams qualify for All-Ireland's.
 - (d) That athletes may compete in a maximum of 2 events in the U9, 10, 11 excluding relays.

Cross Country / Road

1. That 1st, 2nd, and 3rd individuals only lose their status at Munster Novice and Intermediate Cross Country and Road and that team does not lose.
2. That where any athlete competes in a Munster Championship and who does not have a current year's Registration Number at the time, that that athlete automatically disqualifies himself/herself from being entered for the next round of the Championship i.e. National/All-Ireland
3. That, any athlete who has been automatically disqualified for competing in a Munster Championship without a current year's Registration Number may be prohibited from competing in all other Munster Championships/Competitions for the remainder of that calendar year.
