## **Munster Juvenile PRO Report**

## 9 National Juvenile & Youth Combined Events Medals for Munster

The Woodie's DIY AAI Juvenile & Youth Combined Events Championships took place on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2012 in Morton Stadium, Santry. Munster featured strongly in the various age groups with 23 athletes from 7 different Munster Clubs taking part from the Counties below:-

Clare: - St. John's A.C. (2)

Cork:- Belgooly A.C (6), Carrig Na Bhfear A.C (1), Old Abbey A.C. (2) Youghal A.C. (4)

Tipperary: - Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C (1), Nenagh Olympic A.C. (7)

Munster athletes acquitted themselves well winning 3 National titles, 4 Silver & 2 Bronze over the weekend with Daniel Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. taking Gold by a big margin in the Boys U/14 Pentathlon, Deirbhile Ryan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. winning Gold in the Girls U/16 Pentathlon to add to her National Silver Indoor medal in this event & Dan Finnerty, Nenagh Olympic A.C.winning Gold in the Youth Boys (U/17 & U/18) Octathlon to add to his National Silver in Boys U/18 Indoor Pentathlon.

In the Boys U/15 Pentathlon, Tom Deasy, Belgooly A.C. went one place better than the Bronze medal he won at the National Indoor Combined Events earlier this year to win Silver. In the Girls U/16 Pentathlon, Rachel Clancy, St. John's A.C. moved up 2 positions from her 4<sup>th</sup> place in the National Indoors to win her Silver National medal. Belgooly A.C. athletes Grace McKenzie & Sam Healy both won Silver medals in the Youth Girls & Boys (U/17 & U/18) Octathlons. Bronze medals went to Laura Cussen, Old Abbey A.C. in the Girls U/15 Pentathlon to add to her National Indoor Combined Events Bronze medal & Michael Quilligan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. in the Boys U/16 Pentathlon who added bronze to his National Boys U/16 Indoor Combined Events title.

Ciardha Maher, Nenagh Olympic A.C. (Girls U/15 Pentathlon) & Ferghal Curtin, Youghal A.C. (Boys U/15 Pentathlon) both just narrowly missed out on the medals when they placed 4<sup>th</sup> in their competitions with Avril Braham, Carrig na Bhfear A.C. & Paul White, Nenagh Olympic A.C. both finishing in 5<sup>th</sup> place. Other athletes who performed very well were Leah Deasy & Molly Healy, Belgooly A.C. who were 8<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> in the Girls U/14 Pentathlon, Emma Hennessy, Nenagh Olympic A.C., Cliodha Blake, St. John's A.C. & Jennifer Hennessy, Youghal A.C. who were 8<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> in the Girls U/15 Pentathlon, Eoin Hurley, Old Abbey A.C. who was 11<sup>th</sup> in the Boys U/16 Pentathlon, Jayne Pennefather, Belgooly A.C. who was 6<sup>th</sup> in the Youth Girls Octathlon with Faye O'Brien, Youghal A.C. also competing in the same event & Tom Hennessy, Nenagh Olympic A.C. who was 7<sup>th</sup> overall in the Youth Boys Octathlon

with Jack Daly, Youghal A.C. also competing in the same event. Congratulations & well done to everyone.
