## Gold for Ryan & Healy at All Ireland Schools Combined Events

Daniel Ryan, Thurles CBS & Sam Healy, Carrigaline C.S. both won gold in the Junior & Intermediate Boys competitions at the All-Ireland Schools Combined Events Championships in AIT Arena, Athlone on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November. They will now represent Ireland on those teams at the Schools International Combined Events in the Emirates Arena, Glasglow on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> December along with Sophie Meredith, Scoil Mhuire & Ide who was 4<sup>th</sup> in the Junior Girls competition, Damien Hickey, Davis College who was 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Junior Boys competition & Michael Quilligan, Nenagh CBS who was 5<sup>th</sup> in the Intermediate Boys competition. Both Jessica O'Connor, Col Mhuire Ennis & Paul White, Nenagh CBS won bronze in the Senior Girls & Boys competition. Congratulations to all our medal winners & to all the Munster athletes who took part for their schools on the day. An overall summary of Munster results are below:-

In the Junior Girls competition, **Sophie Meredith, Scoil Mhuire & Ide** finished 4<sup>th</sup> overall on 3086 points with **Vickie Cusack, Nagle Rice Secondary School** in 7<sup>th</sup> place on 2902 points, **Lauren Moylan, Nenagh College** 9<sup>th</sup> on 2610 points, **Eimear Linehan, Hazelwood College** 10<sup>th</sup> on 2527 points & **Ella Nicholson, Bandon Grammer School** 11<sup>th</sup> on 2521 points.

In the Junior Boys competition, there was gold for **Daniel Ryan, Thurles CBS** who won comfortably with 3245 points with **Damien Hickey, Davis College** 3<sup>rd</sup> on 2573 points & **Diarmuid Clancy, Meanscoil San Nicholas** 6<sup>th</sup> on 2378 points. **David O'Brien, St. Clements** had to withdraw from the competition after the Long Jump due to injury.

In the Intermediate Girls competition, Laura Cussen Col Choilim, Ballincollig finished in 5th place with a score of **2,809 points** with Laoise Bennis, Hazelwood College 8<sup>th</sup> on 2271 points, Rachel Clancy, Colaiste Mhuire, Ennis in 9<sup>th</sup> place on 2,268 points & Alison Healy, Hazelwood College 10<sup>th</sup> on 1798 points.

**Sam Healy Carrigaline C.S** won Gold in the Intermediate boy's event with a score of **3,389 points** just 4 points ahead of 2<sup>nd</sup> place with **Michael Quilligan, Nenagh CBS** in 5<sup>th</sup> place on 3030 points & **Laju Uwatse Sal Palliskenry** 13<sup>th</sup> on 2487 points.

**Jessica O'Connor, Col Mhuire Ennis** won bronze in the Senior Girls competition finishing on 2210 points with **Paul White, Nenagh CBS** winning Bronze in the Senior Boys category finishing on 2445 points & **Sean O'Dalaigh Gaelcholaiste Corcaigh** in 5<sup>th</sup> place on1690 points.
