Double Titles for Morrison & Mulcaire

The second day of the Munster Cross Country season took place on Sunday 10th November in Castlelyons, Co. Cork with the Munster Juvenile Uneven Age Cross Country Championships. Our thanks to St. Nicholas A.C. for hosting this event which was expertly managed from start to finish.

Stand-out performances came for **Sarah Morrison** of the host Club **St. Nicholas A.C. & Kevin Mulcaire, Ennis Track A.C.** when they both won their races making them double Munster Champions in & out of their age groups with Sarah winning the Girls U/11 & U/12 titles & Kevin the Boys U/17 & U/18 titles.

This time around, Cork & Clare battled it out for the major individual medals with both Counties winning 5 individual titles each. For Cork there was gold for Sarah Morrison, St. Nicholas A.C. in the Girls U/11 & John O'Flynn in the Boys U/11, Ursula Bluett, North Cork A.C. & Adam O'Reilly, Togher A.C. in the Girls & Boys U/13 races & Louise Shanahan, Leevale A.C. in the Girls U/17. Clare athletes who won gold were Ellen Carey, Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C. in the Girls U/9, Aisling Kelly, St. John's A.C. in the Girls U/15, Kevin Mulcaire, Ennis Track A.C. in the Boys U/17, Laura Power, Ennis Track A.C. in the Girls U/19 & Karl Fitzmaurice, Bridge Milers Olympic Harriers A.C. in the Boys U/19. The remaining 2 titles went to Tipperary (Joe Egan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C.) & Waterford (Michael Power, West Waterford A.C.).

In the Inter-County competition, **Cork** won 8 titles in the Boys U/9, U/13, U/17 & U/19 Girls U/11, U/13, U/15, & U/19 with **Clare** winning 3 titles in the Girls U/9, Boys U/11 & U/15 & **Waterford** winning one title in the Girls U/17 competition.

Top 3 in the Girls U/9 race were Ellen Carey, Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C., Michelle Healy, Marian A.C. & Emer Conroy, Dooneen A.C. with the top 3 Clubs being Ennis Track A.C., Youghal A.C. & West Waterford. Inter-County honours went to Clare (1st), Cork (2nd) & Limerick (3rd). In the Boys U/9 race, gold went to Joe Egan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C., silver to James O'Neill, West Muskerry A.C. & bronze to Cathal Barry, Riverstick/Kinsale A.C. Top 3 team prizes went to Nenagh Olympic A.C., Bandon A.C. & Ennis Track A.C. with Inter-County honours to Cork, Tipperary & Clare.

The Girls U/11 title went to **Sarah Morrison, St. Nicholas A.C.** who also won the Munster U/12 title a few weeks back with **Meghan Carr-O Reilly, St. Catherine's A.C.** in 2nd place (to add to her bronze medal U/12) & Mallaidh O' Neill, Skibbereen A.C. in 3rd place. Team prizes were won by **West Muskerry A.C., Ennis Track A.C. & Bandon A.C.** with **Cork, Clare & Tipperary** winning Inter-County

medals. John O'Flynn, North Cork A.C. took gold in the Boys U/11 race with Diarmuid Healy, Midleton A.C. in 2nd place (to add to his Munster gold U/10) & Mark Hanrahan, Ennis Track A.C. in 3rd place. Team credits went to Ennis Track A.C., St. Cronan's A.C. & Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C. with Inter-County wins for Clare, Cork & Tipperary.

Ursula Bluett, North Cork A.C. was the winner of the Girls U/13 title with Jennifer Cotter, West Muskerry A.C. in 2nd place & Caoimhe Duffy Niblock, Ferrybank A.C. in 3rd place. Ferrybank A.C. won gold in the team event with West Muskerry A.C. in 2nd place & West Waterford A.C. in 3rd. There were Inter-County medals for Cork, Clare & Waterford. In the Boys U/13 race there was gold for Adam O'Reilly, Togher A.C., silver for Finn Looney, Emerald A.C. & bronze for Ben Whelehan, Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C. (to add to his Munster U/12 gold) with team honours for Togher A.C., West Waterford A.C. & Kilmurray Ibrickane A.C. Inter-County medals went to Cork, Clare & Waterford.

In the Girls U/15 race, there was a reversal of places from the U/16 race a few weeks back with Aisling Kelly, St. John's A.C. taking gold & Caoimhe Harrington, West Muskerry A.C. winning silver & Caoimhe Harvey, St. John's A.C. in 3rd place (to add to her bronze U/16 medal). West Waterford A.C., Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C. & Bandon A.C. were the top 3 winners in the team competition with Cork, Clare & Waterford all winning Inter-County medals. In the Boys U/15 race, it was gold for Michael Power, West Waterford A.C. (to add to his bronze U/16 medal), with silver for Eoin Looney, Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C. & bronze for Jamie Roche, Ennis Track A.C. with team honours going to Ennis Track A.C., Waterford A.C. & West Waterford A.C. & Inter-County medals for Clare, Cork & Waterford.

Louise Shanahan, Leevale A.C. won gold in the Girls U/17 race (to add to her silver U/18 medal) with **Orla Quelly, Ferrybank A.C.** in 2nd place & **Aoife Hamilton, West Waterford A.C.** in 3rd place. There were team wins for **West Waterford A.C.**, **Bandon A.C.** & **Togher A.C.** with Inter-County medals for **Waterford & Cork. Kevin Mulcaire, Ennis Track A.C.** did the double when he added the U/17 Munster title to his U/18 title won a few weeks ago with **David Fox, Leevale A.C.** in 2nd place (to add to his bronze U/18 medal) & winner of the Boys U/16 Munster title, **Fearghal Curtin, Youghal A.C.** in 3rd place. The top 3 Clubs were **Leevale A.C., Nenagh Olympic A.C.** & **Ennis Track A.C.** with **Cork, Waterford & Tipperary** winning Inter-County medals.

Laura Power, Ennis Track A.C. won the title in the Girls U/19 race with Rachel O'Shea, West Muskerry A.C. in 2nd place & Laura Egan, Kilmihil A.C. in 3rd place. Carrig Na Bhfear A.C. won the team title with Cork taking the Inter-County title. Karl Fitzmaurice, Bridge Milers Olympic Harriers A.C. took the Boys U/19 title with Tom Hennessy, Nenagh Olympic A.C. in 2nd place & Conor O'Mahoney, Tralee Harriers A.C. in 3rd place with team honours going to Leevale A.C. & Carrig Na Bhfear A.C. & the Inter-County title to Cork.
