Numbers Up at Munster Combined Events Championships

There was very strong support for the Munster Juvenile Combined Events Championships in Cork I.T. on Sunday 28th April with a total of 147 athletes taking part from U/11 to Youth age groups. All 6 Munster counties were represented with 78 boys & 69 girls from 25 different clubs competing. The largest number of competitors was in the Boys U/11 (21), Girls U/12 (23), Boys U/12 (16), Boys U/13 (15) & Boys U/14 (15) categories. With 13 Munster titles up for decision on the day (there were no Youth Boys competing), Liscarroll A.C. & St. Mary's A.C., Limerick won two titles each & Nenagh Olympic A.C. & Carrig naBhfear A.C. won 1 each in the Girls competition. In the Boys competition, there were two titles each for Nenagh Olympic A.C. & Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. with Bandon A.C. & Belgooly A.C. winning 1 each. Thanks to Chris O'Regan for co-ordinating all the officials for the day & to everyone who volunteered to help, for without you all, we could not run these Championships.

The level of competition was high on the day with reigning Munster & National Indoor Combined Events Champions, **Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C.** (Girls U/14), **David Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C.** (Boys U/14) & **Daniel Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C.** (Boys U/15) showing good form & adding Munster Outdoor titles to their repertoires. Other Munster & National Indoor medal winners, **Padraig Nash Belgooly A.C.** & **Jack Fallon, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C.** won Silver & Bronze in the Boys U/14 competition & **Jayne Pennefather** (Individual) who was 4th in the National Youth Pentathlon took Munster gold in the Youth Girls competition.

3 Championship Best Performances & 1 equalled CBP were also recorded on the day by the following athletes:-

- Niamh Foley, St. Mary's A.C. ran 8.63 in the Girls U/12 60m to break the existing record of 8.71 set by Lauren O'Leary, Liscarroll A.C. in 2012.
- Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. jumped 4.91m in the Girls U/13 Long Jump to break the existing record of 4.87m set by Mairead O' Sullivan, West Muskerry A.C. in 1996.
- Daniel Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. ran 11.72 in the Boys U/15 80m Hurdles to break the existing record of 11.85 set by Michael Quilligan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. in 2011.
- Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. jumped 1.45m in the Girls U/13 High Jump to equal the existing record of 1.45m set by Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C. in 2012.

Holly McCarthy, Liscarroll A.C. won the Girls U/11 competition (791 points) with Praise Owoeye, Ferrybank A.C. in 2nd place (778) & Susan Nestor, St. Mary's A.C., Clare in 3rd place (747). Holly Meredith, St. Mary's A.C., Limerick took the title in the Girls U/12 (1791) with her team-mate Alannah Keyes, St. Mary's A.C. in 2nd place (1524) & Ciara Kenneally, Gneeveguilla A.C. in 3rd place (1488). St. Mary's A.C., Limerick took their 2nd Munster title in the Girls U/13 with Holly's sister Sophie Meredith winning gold (1344), Aisling Cassidy, Bandon A.C. silver (965) & Aishat Olatunji, Midleton A.C. winning bronze (883). Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C. won the Girls U/14 title (2925), Moira Barrett, Bandon A.C. was in 2nd place (2403) & Lauren Moylan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. just 2 points behind in 3rd place (2401). In the Girls U/15 competition, there was gold for Avril Braham, Carrig na Bhfear A.C. (2763), silver for Sinead O'Regan, Ferrybank A.C. (2592) & bronze for Tara Bradley, St. John's A.C. (2522). Emma Hennessy, Nenagh Olympic A.C. took the title in the Girls U/16 (3118) with Cliodha Blake, St. John's A.C. in 2nd place (2738) & Kelly Devine, St. Mary's A.C., Limerick in 3rd place (2337). Jayne Pennefather (Individual) won the Youth Girls competition with 2559 points with **Jessica O'Connor, Marian A.C.** in 2nd place (2081) & **Lauren Kenneally, Gneeveguilla A.C.** in 3rd place (1678).

In the Boys U/11 competition, there was gold for Mark Collin, Bandon A.C. (830), silver for Mel Deasy, Old Abbey A.C. (790) & bronze for Shane Fitzgerald, St. Mary's A.C., Limerick (787). Aaron Walsh, Nenagh Olympic A.C. won the Boys U/12 (1769) with Conor Blake, St. John's A.C. in 2nd (1577) & Adam O'Dwyer, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. in 3rd place (1555). Sean Carolan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. took the title in the Boys U/13 competition (1245) with his team-mate Joseph McEvoy in 2nd place (1187) & Tom Gallagher, Ferrybank A.C. in 3rd place (1179). There was gold for David Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. in the Boys U/14 competition (2049), silver for Padraig Nash, Belgooly A.C. (1887) & bronze for Jack Fallon, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. (1601). Daniel Ryan, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C. was the clear winner of the Boys U/15 competition (3424) with Sean Broderick, Youghal A.C. in 2nd place (2770) & Diarmuid Clancy, Abbey Striders A.C. in 3rd place (2666). In the Boys U/16 competition, Tom Deasy, Belgooly A.C. took gold (2214) with Caolan O'Brien, Midleton A.C. in 2nd place (1541) & Conor Sexton, Abbey Striders A.C. in 3rd place (1319). Congratulations to all who took part & in particular to the medal winners. The National Combined Events Championships will take place on Saturday 10th & Sunday 11th August 2013.
