## **Munster Juvenile & Youth Combined Events Championships**

The Munster Juvenile & Youth Combined Events Championships were held in Templemore Track on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2016 with competition for U/11 to Youth (U/17 & U/18) age groups. 5 Championship Best Performances (1 individual & 4 Pentathlon) were recorded on the day by the following athletes:-

- **Hannah Falvey, Belgooly A.C.** ran a very swift 8.82 in the Girls U/11 60m to break the time of 8.92 set by Brenda Doherty, K.C.K. A.C. in 2000.
- Maia McCourt, Bandon A.C. won the Girls U/11 competition scoring a new CBP of 873 points to exceed the score of 816 points set by Grace Rooney, Youghal A.C. in 2015.
- **George Alamu, Midleton A.C.** scored 1445 points in the Boys U/12 competition to beat the score of 1431 set by his team-mate Sean Kavanagh in 2015.
- Laura Frawley, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick scored a total of 1692 points in the Girls U/13 competition to exceed the score of 1517 points set by Susan Nestor, St. Mary's A.C. Clare in 2015.
- Anne Corcoran, Ferrybank A.C. set a new record in the Youth Girls Pentathlon with her final score of 3096 to beat the score of 2795 points set by Cliodha Blake, St. John's A.C. Clare set in 2015.

Maia McCourt, Bandon A.C. won the Girls U/11 competition (873 points) with Hannah Falvey, Belgooly A.C. in 2<sup>nd</sup> place (861) & Leagh Moloney, Dooneen A.C. in 3<sup>rd</sup> place (788). Ava Rochford, Ennis Track A.C. took the title in the Girls U/12 (1379) with Emer Conroy, Dooneen A.C. in 2<sup>nd</sup> place (1315) & Jessica Lyne, Leevale A.C. in 3<sup>rd</sup> place (1263). Laura Frawley, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick took the Munster title in the Girls U/13 (1692) scoring a new CBP with Neassa Towey, Templemore A.C. in 2<sup>nd</sup> place (1331) & Maria Campbell, Dooneen A.C. in 3<sup>rd</sup> place (1313). Susan Nestor, St. Mary's A.C. Clare was the winner of the Girls U/14 competition (2701) with Aoife O'Sullivan, Liscarroll A.C. in 2<sup>nd</sup> place (2371) & Ellen Dillon, Dooneen A.C. in 3<sup>rd</sup> place (2294). There was a win in the Girls U/15 competition for Ava Fennessy, Clonmel A.C. (2748) with team-mate Orla Winston in 2<sup>nd</sup> place (2688). In the Girls U/16 competition, there was gold for Emily O'Mahoney, Waterford A.C. (2448) while in the Youth Girls competition, there was gold for Anne Corcoran, Ferrybank A.C. & a new CBP of 3096 points with silver for Aoibhinn O'Connor, Bandon A.C. on 2465 points.
