Strong Showing from Munster Athletes on Day 1



Munster athletes showed good form at Day 1 of the GloHealth National Juvenile Track & Field Championships in Tullamore on Sunday 10th July 2016 winning 68 medals in total which included 27 gold & national titles, 21 silver & 20 bronze & 4 new National records set by the athletes below:-

- 1. **Laura Frawley, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick** ran 9.52 in the Girls U/13 60mH to better the time of 9.58 set by Miriam Daly, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. in 2013.
- 2. **Sean Kavanagh, Midleton A.C.** jumped 1.56 in the Boys U/13 High Jump to break the 2014 record of 1.48m set by his team-mate Robert Dillon in 2014.
- 3. **Megan Lenihan, North Cork A.C.** threw 39.07m in the Girls U/14 Javelin to better the 2012 record held by Orlaith O'Brien, Ferrybank A.C. at 34.36m.
- 4. **Jack Murphy, Leevale A.C.** ran 15.09 in the Boys U/19 110mH to break the 2002 record of 15.19 set by Ian McDonald, Crusaders A.C.

(4.56m) & bronze for Sean Carmody, Belgooly A.C. (4.48m). In the Girls U/12 Turbo Javelin, Munster dominated again with gold for Selena O'Riordan, Midleton A.C. (24.72m), silver for Ava Rochford, Ennis Track A.C. (22.80m) & bronze for Kaley Cozens, Templemore A.C. (22.37m). Tara Hickey, Youghal A.C. won joint bronze in the Girls U/12 High Jump with Ava Rochford, Ennis Track A.C. (1.25m).

U/13

Laura Frawley, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick won gold in the Girls U/13 60mH in a record time of 9.52 with bronze for Ella Scott, Leevale A.C. (9.81). Harry Nevin, Leevale A.C. also took gold in the Boys U/13 60mH in a time of 9.52 with bronze for Sarah Hosey, Dooneen A.C. in the Girls U/13 600m (1.40.78). Sean Kavanagh, Midleton A.C. won the Boys U/13 High Jump with a new National record of 1.56m with bronze for Alex Reynolds, Nenagh Olympic A.C. (1.53m) & there was gold for Jack Cullen, Bandon A.C. in the Boys U/13 Javelin with a throw of 34.27m & silver for Donnacha Morrissey, Kilmurray/Ibrickane A.C. (30.72m).

U/14

Reece Ademola, Leevale A.C. took gold in the Boys U/14 75mH in a time of 11.55 with silver for Hollie McCarthy, Liscarroll A.C. in the Girls U/14 75mH (11.82). There was also gold & silver for Munster in the Girls U/14 800m with a win for Ailbhe Doherty, Ennis Track A.C. (2.19.13) & silver for Aimee Hayde, Newport A.C. (2.19.76). Megan Lenihan, North Cork A.C. won gold in the Girls U/14 Javelin with a new National record of 39.07m with bronze for Katelyn Reid, An Riocht A.C. (35.88m) who also won silver in the Hammer with a throw of 29.31m. Aoife O'Sullivan, Liscarroll A.C. won silver in the Girls U/14 High Jump (1.50m) with bronze for her Club-mate Joe Ivory in the Boys U/14 Javelin (36.00m) & bronze for Josh Delaney, Nenagh Olympic A.C. in the Hammer (38.73m).



Munster athletes performed the double in the 80mH with gold for Niamh Foley, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick (11.97) & Daniel Hurley, Leevale A.C. (11.68) & gold also for Tommy Connolly, Leevale A.C. in the Boys U/15 800m (2.11.74). Ciara Sheehy, Liscarroll A.C. won silver in the Girls U/15 Hammer with a throw of 38.83m with gold & silver for Holly Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick & Kylie Heinen, Ferrybank A.C. in the Girls U/15 High Jump (1.55m & 1.50m). Cathal Scanlon, Waterford A.C. won silver in the Boys U/15 Javelin (42.10m).

U/16

Miriam Daly, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. won gold in the Girls U/16 80mH in a time of 11.48 with gold & silver for Darragh Miniter, St. Mary's A.C. Clare & Joseph McEvoy, Nenagh Olympic A.C. in the Boys U/16 100mH (13.55 & 13.64). McEvoy also won silver in the Boys U/16 High Jump (1.81m) & gold in the Boys U/16 Long Jump with 6.36m with silver for Brian Lynch, Old Abbey A.C. (6.12m). In the Boys U/16 Discus, Darragh Miniter won his 2nd gold medal with a throw of 43.77m with bronze for Sean Carolan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. (42.97m). In the Girls U/16 Discus, it was silver for Martha Quain, Carraig na BhFear A.C. (33.42m) & bronze for Shauna Linehan, North Cork A.C. (26.53m). Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick won silver in the Girls U/16 Long Jump with a leap of 5.59m with silver for Elizabeth Stack, Killarney Valley A.C. in the Girls U/16 High Jump (1.50m).

U/17

There was a Munster double in the Long Jump competitions with gold for Aoibhinn O'Connor, Bandon A.C. (5.19m) & James Murphy, Waterford A.C. (6.48m). Sean Mockler, Moycarkey Coolcroo A.C won gold in the Boys U/17 Discus (39.35m) with silver for Shane Monagle, Tramore A.C. in the 110mH (15.02). Lauren O'Grady. St. Brendan's A.C. won bronze in the Girls U/17 Discus (30.53m) with Vickie Cusack, Liscarroll A.C. also winning bronze in the Shot Putt (10.40m). Alex O'Neill, St. Cronan's A.C. won silver in the 800m (2.24.01) with gold for Laura Nicholson, Bandon A.C. in the 2km Steeplechase (7.47.69) & silver for Alannah Neff, Leevale A.C. (8.00.16).
