30 National Titles for Munster Athletes on Day 3





Munster athletes continued their winning ways on Day 3 of the Irish Life Health National Juvenile Track & Field Championships in Tullamore on Sunday 22nd July 2018 winning <u>63</u> medals in total (30 gold, 15 silver & 18 bronze). <u>3</u> National records were also set by the athletes below:-

- Aimee Hayde, Newport A.C. ran 4.30.91 in the Girls U/16 1500m to better the 2010 record of 4.36.29 set by Siofra Cleirigh Buttner, DSD A.C.
- Harry Nevin, Leevale A.C. ran 33.28 in the Boys U/15 250mH to better the time of 33.81 set by Kolade Abiodun, Donore Harriers A.C. set in 2014.
- Glory Wenegieme, Belgooly A.C. ran 22.88 in the Boys U/15 200m to better the time of 23.27 set by Tony Odubote, Ennis Track A.C. in 2014.

Among the stars on the day were Aimee Hayde, Newport A.C. who added another gold and record to her existing 800m title & record on Day 1 by winning the 1500m and setting another record; Grace Rooney, Youghal A.C. added a third gold to her winnings taking the title in the Girls U/14 200m to add to her 75mH and 80m including a new national record; Shane Monagle, Tramore A.C. took victory in the Boys U/19 200m adding to his golds in the 110mH & 100m on Day 1; Harry Nevin, Leevale A.C. added a second gold to his national tally by winning the Boys U/15 250mH in a record time of 33.81 having won gold in the 80mH & silver in the Long Jump on Day 1 & 2; Glory Wenegieme, Belgooly A.C. won the Boys U/15 200m with a new CBP to add to his gold in the 100m on Day 2; Lucy May Sleeman, Leevale A.C. won bronze in the Girls U/15 200m to add to her double gold won in the 80m & 80mH on Day 1; Timmy Wilk, Ballymore Cobh A.C. added another gold in the Boys U/14 200m to his previous winnings of gold in the Boys U/14 Long Jump & silver in the 80m; Jack Cullen, Bandon A.C. won double gold in the Boys U/15 Triple Jump & Javelin; Sean Carolan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. won bronze in the Boys U/18 Discus to add to his silver in the Shot Putt & Javelin and bronze in the Long Jump; Darragh Miniter, St. Mary's A.C. Lauren Cadden (Sligo) ran 24.48 seconds to win the girls U19 200m in a new championship best performance with Israel Olatunde (Dundealgan) running 22.16 seconds to win the U17 boys 200m.

Grace Rooney (Youghal) won the U14 girls 200m in 25.87 with Timmy Wilk (Ballymore Cobh) winning the boys U14 200m in 25.23.

Harry Nevin (Leevale) set a new CBP of 33.28 seconds in the boys U15 250m hurdles to bag another gold medal.
